- The full paper should not exceed 3000 words and must include a proper title, author(s) name, designation institution, and complete address for correspondence.
- Language: Paper should be submitted either in Assamese or English
- References should adhere to the 7th edition of APA style.
- Both abstract and full papers should be submitted in MS Word, using Times New Roman, font size 12, and 1.5 spacing. Assamese papers should be typed in PageMaker, Geetanjali font, size 14pt.
- Participants should send their abstract and paper to rangiattcollegeseminar@gmail.com
- There will also be provision for online presentation of papers. For online presentation participants have to contact by 30th December, 2025.
- Selected papers will be published in the form of an edited book with ISBN.
